EQUITY HEALTH PLAN FOR THE PERMANENTLY DISABLED AGED AND POOR PERSONS (SKSHP-EHP-DAP)

DEFINITION

The Equity Health Plan for Permanently Disabled, Aged and the Poor (DAP) is a programme designed to provide Healthcare Services to Permanently Disabled Persons, Aged and the Poor, who due to their condition cannot engage in any economically productive activity.

MEMBERSHIP

Permanently Disabled Persons, Aged () and the Poor will be registered in collaboration with the Ministry for Social Welfare, Sokoto State Zakat Commission, Philanthropists, Donor Agencies and other stakeholders. This will make for easy identification and coordination.

CONTRIBUTIONS:

The Federal, States, Local Governments, Sokoto State Zakat Commission, Development Partners and Non-Governmental Organisations will pay contributions in advance.

PROVIDER PAYMENT SYSTEM

Payment at Primary level will be by Capitation, while fee -for-service shall be employed at the Secondary level.

The rate to be paid to Health Care Providers will be determined by actuarial analysis and shall be reviewed from time to time.
